2. Classroom activities during the two weeks prior to the performance are available and highly encouraged. There FREE resources include:

Overview letter of The Elixir of Love school performance;

Story synopsis through animation via YouTube links, and written;

Introduction to major arias, duets and student roles in performances via YouTube links;

Classroom discussion questions designed to supports students in finding personal meaning in the story and developing critical thinking skills.

Detailed Study Guide including classroom activities, operatic themes, opera dictionary, and music selections via YouTube links.

Reduction script to encourage student engagement in the performance.

3. LVOpera encourages student engagement, definitely! The non-singing, non-voiced student parts are:

Five Soldier Parts Five Village Girl Parts Five Village Boy Parts

The Fifteen student participants are provided with costumes and a brief rehearsal with the singers fifteen minutes prior to the performance. Full script (libretto) is provided with the student parts highlighted. One teacher, at the school, takes the lead on selection and on rehearsal of student parts.

4. The LVOpera's classroom activities encourage students to develop their critical thinking skills, allow students to discover something that they may have never heard or seen before, as well as fulfill California Standards for Music Education that include common core and cross-cultural discussion, and communication as addressed under *Responding to Artistic Works:*

- Anchor Standard 8: Interpret Intent and Meaning in Artistic Work
- Anchor Standard 9: Apply Criteria to Evaluate Artistic Work
- Anchor Standard 11: Relate Artistic Ideas and Works with Societal, Cultural, and Historical Context to Deepen Understanding.
